Chair Harrell and representatives of each municipality (the Cities of McDonough, Stockbridge, Locust Grove and Hampton) called their respective meetings to order.

Ms. Mack provided an overview of the proposed Intergovernmental Agreement between the county and the municipalities.

The Intergovernmental Agreement must be approved by the Board of Commissioners and a majority of local City Councils representing at least 50% of the municipal population. The county's goal is to have the participation of every city.

Benefits of the IGA:

- The IGA allows the T-SPLOST program to operate for the full six-year period.
- The T-SPLOST program would remain in place for the full duration, providing greater certainty for the county and cities when planning projects, even if revenues reach projected levels earlier than expected due to strong economic activity.
- Every city receives a portion of collections to complete projects within their community.
- Population figures will be based on the 2024 population.

Next Steps:

- Finalize the Intergovernmental Agreement with the BOC and City Councils
- Finalize the county project list and each city's project list
- The county requests the city councils approve the IGA by July 15. The BOC plans to consider adopting the IGA and calling the referendum at the July 21 meeting.
- Election Day: November 3, 2026
