B. Adoption of 2021-2022 Millage Rate (Presenters: Cheri Hobson-Matthews, County Manager; and Michael Harris, Tax Commissioner)

VOTE: Commissioner Thomas made a motion to approve county-wide millage rate of 8.788 for Henry County; Commissioner Cannon seconded. The motion carried 5-0-0.

Millage rates were adopted separately for each Special District:

VOTE: Commissioner Thomas made a motion to approve millage rate of **1.824 for the Police Protection Special District**; Commissioner Cannon seconded. The motion carried 5-0-0.

VOTE: Commissioner Cannon made a motion to approve millage rate of **1.105 for the Fire Protection Special District**; Commissioner Thomas seconded. The motion carried 5-0-0.

VOTE: Commissioner Thomas made a motion to approve millage rate of **0.685 for the Recreation Special District**; Commissioner Cannon seconded. The motion carried 5-0-0.

VOTE: Commissioner Cannon made a motion to approve millage rate of **0.331 for the Unincorporated Services Special District**; Commissioner Thomas seconded. The motion carried 5-0-0.

FINAL VOTE for approval of complete resolution as presented which includes the imposed overall millage rate of 12.733 for fiscal year 2022, public-school millage rate of 20.00 mills; school bond millage rate of 3.628 mills; water and sewer bonds at 2.00 mills; as well as the other millage rates approved above and read into the record. Commissioner Cannon made a motion to approve; Commissioner Thomas seconded. The motion carried 5-0-0
